SURVEYOR PROGRAM

The Florida Training Services, Surveyor Assistant, Instruments and Geodetic Computator Programs are designed to assist local surveying firms offering training to their current employees or helping them find new ones through our school. This helps provide a well-trained and documented workforce.

WHAT IS SURVEYING AND MAPPING TECHNICIANS APPRENTICESHIP?

- § If you enjoy being outside, working with others and processing technical information, a career in surveying could be perfect for you.
- § Surveying and mapping technicians measure the ground surface, layout and structures, and the preparation of maps, profiles, cross sections and alignments.
- § Surveying and mapping technicians assist Surveyors by collecting data in the field, making calculations, and helping with computer-aided drafting.
- § Apprenticeship training is a highly structured training program consisting of on-the-job training and related technical instruction in the classroom.



These programs are overseen by the Apprenticeship Training Committee. The programs are registered with the State of Florida Department of Education. Surveyor Assistant, Instruments and Geodetic Computator are two year programs consisting of a minimum of 144 hours each of related classroom instruction and a minimum of 2000 hours of on-the-job training to develop and maintain a skilled workforce for the Surveying and Mapping industry.
