Carpenters traditionally worked with natural wood and do the rougher work such as framing, today many other materials are also used and sometimes the finer trades of cabinetmaking and furniture building are considered carpentry.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Florida Training Services offers a 4 year Registered Carpentry Apprenticeship program in which you can work in the construction field during the day and take classes at night.

All apprentices are required to attend a minimum of 144 hours per year of related classroom training. This training is provided in person at Sheridan Technical College located in Broward County Florida. Apprentices are required minimum of 2000 hours per year of on the job training. All progress is documented with the sponsoring employer along with all completed Safety Courses.


REQUIREMENTS:
